This is an excellent engagement with the research report that evidences a strong grasp of a range of methodological issues. The review concentrates on difficulties that the author finds with the research and explains these using appropriate methodological language. Clearly, there was more to be said and I would have liked to see a greater emphasis on the basis for the claims that the researchers actually did make, but given that there is very little wasted text in the review and that the criticisms made are justified, this limitation can be excused.
